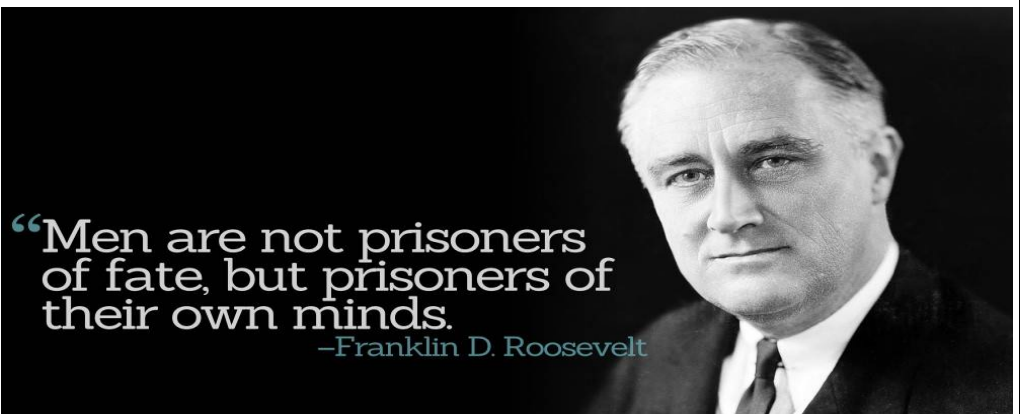
Master's Minute

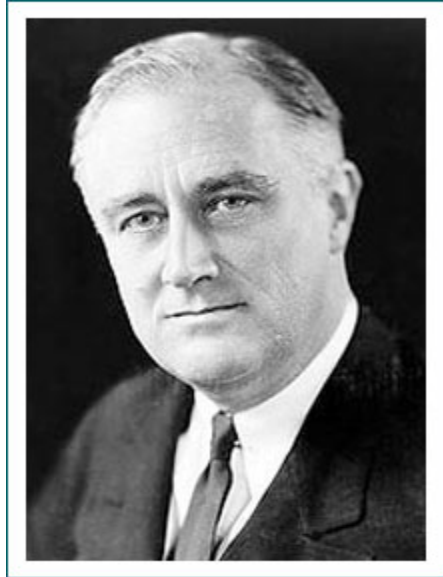
What's New

Famous Freemasons: Franklin D. Roosevelt

Franklin Delano Roosevelt was born in Hyde Park, NY on January 30th, 1882. A Harvard graduate, he attended Columbia Law School and was admitted to the New York bar. In 1910 he was elected to the New York State Senate, and in 1912 he was appointed Assistant Sec. of the Navy by Woodrow Wilson. He ran as VP with James M. Cox in 1920, but after their defeat he returned to law practice in NY. It was shortly thereafter that he was stricken with Polio and lost most of the use of his legs. In 1928 he ran for Governor of New York, was elected and served two terms before being nominated to run for President in 1932, to which he was also elected.



Finding the country in the grips of the great depression, Roosevelt introduced several programs with the hopes of revitalizing the nations economy and spirit. His "New Deal" as it became known helped to do just that. His popularity became so great he became the only President to be elected to four terms. It was during his third term the United States entered World War II, and Roosevelt temporarily shelved the New Deal in order to get full production during the war and to prepare the way for a united acceptance of peace settlements after the war. A series of conferences with Winston Churchill and Joseph Stalin laid down the basis for the postwar world. It was shortly after his fourth term election that he suffered a cerebral hemorrhage and passed away on April 12th, 1945.

Right Worshipful Brother Roosevelt was Initiated, Passed, and Raised in Holland Lodge No. 8 in New York City. He received the Scottish Rite degrees in Albany, NY, and was also a member of the Grotto and the Tall Cedars. He was "Right Worshipful" having been accredited the representative of the Grand Lodge of Georgia near the Grand Lodge of New York in 1930.
